THE MISSION

Thank you for considering investing in the Dominican! This trip is in partnership with Freedom Ministries who run a local school located 25 minutes north of San Pedro de Macoris on the south coast of the Dominican Republic, east of Santo Domingo. The closest town to the campus is Ramon Santana.

Getting involved by physically coming to serve in our local school is extremely helpful. For those who will be building, each block laid represents opportunity for our children. For those working in the school, your ability (speaking English!) greatly equips our students. These children benefit from the one-on-one attention they receive and learn to develop good relationships as a result of their interactions with others. If you find yourself involved in other areas at Freedom, we believe that regardless of what you do, you're a missionary. Each person plays an integral role in the big picture. We're excited about the possibility of partnering with you as God continues to do His work here in the Dominican!

There are many reasons for serving on a short-term trip. Ultimately, we want your purposes for coming to align with our purposes for having you here. Because all that we do should be glorifying to the Lord, we wouldn't want to encourage teams to spend the time and resources to come if doing so would be bad stewardship. So











why come? First, we are hoping that those who visit Freedom would consider being a part of the ministry in the long term. This can be done from anywhere in the world by being a "champion" for Freedom. We'll talk about this opportunity during your week here, but we want you to come prepared to answer this question: "What can I do to help Freedom long term with what God is doing in the Dominican Republic?"

Second, we're hoping that team members who come on this trip will walk away with a greater desire to glorify God in their particular circumstances. Specifically, we're praying that you would either embrace new ways of looking at things or that you would be more firmly convinced of truths that you already hold to. We believe that each time you love on one of the kids in the bateyes, there is the potential for impact. We've seen the Lord use groups to establish a greater connection between Freedom and the people that He has called us to minister to. Past group members continue to ask about and pray for individuals they met on their trips. We know that connections are being made and that lives are being changed!

LODGING & TRANSPORTATION

Teams have the option of choosing to fly in and out of two different airports. We understand that your airport preference will be driven by flight options, cost, and personal preference. However, we strongly encourage you to fly into SDQ, arriving between 10 AM and 8 PM.

- Las Américas International Airport (SDQ) This airport is located in Santo Domingo, which is about 45 minutes from our campus.
- Punta Cana International Airport (PUJ) This airport is located in Punta Cana, which is about 1 ½ hours from our campus.

All teams stay on the Freedom campus along with our missionary families. The campus is very clean and very safe. However, there are some things to be aware of:

- Our sleeping accommodations are dormitory style. All guys will be in one dorm and all females will be in another. No one is allowed in the dorm room of the opposite sex.
- Each dorm room has a connected bathroom with multiple showers, toilets, and sinks.
- Linens and bath towels are provided for every team member.
- The dorm rooms will not be air conditioned, although fans will be provided.

All travelers are now required to complete an "E-ticket" prior to airport check-in from the U.S.A. or from the Dominican Republic. This electronic form combines the Traveler's Health Affidavit, Customs Declaration and International Embarkation/Disembarkation forms that traveler's used to fill out on the airplane into one online process.
