# VISIT LONDON EST. 50AD

*London...* As one of the world's top destinations, London is a bevy of English bobbies, an ocean of black umbrellas, and an unconquered continuance of more than 2,000 years of history. And boy, do they love sport! Now an uber-cool city, London remains history-steeped. Buildings are eye-catching milestones in the city's unique and compelling biography. There's more than enough funky innovation to put a crackle in the air, but it never drowns out London's well-preserved, centuries-old narrative. Architectural grandeur rises up all around you, ancient remains dot the city and charming pubs punctuate the Thames riverside. A tireless innovator of art and culture, London is a city of ideas, imagination, art and history all rolled into one. And while English may be the national tongue, over 300 languages shape London's linguistic soundscape. These languages also represent cultures that season the culinary aromas on London's streets, the clothing you glimpse and the music you hear. It can seem like the whole world has come to town. London's diverse cultural dynamism makes it quite possibly the world's most international city, while being somehow intrinsically British.

## *Did you know?*

- ✓ There are **92 professional football clubs** in the UK. Cricket is the national sport and became popular in the U.K. in the 17<sup>th</sup> century.
- ✓ Her Majesty the Queen is not allowed to go into the House of Commons because she is not a commoner.
- ✓ Rumor has it that Windsor Castle is haunted by a range of ghosts, including King Henry VIII, Queen Elizabeth I, Mad King George, and Charles I.
- ✓ About sixteen percent of the UK's restaurants are located in London, and there are more Michelin-rated restaurants in London than in any city except for Paris.
- ✓ The Queen's official residence, Buckingham Palace, was built in 1702... on the site of a notorious brothel!
- ✓ Harrods, London's most famous shop, once used a cobra to guard a valuable pair of sandals. They were priced at £62,000 and were covered in diamonds and sapphires.
- ✓ Cab drivers in London are special. To become a taxi driver, they must pass 'The Knowledge Test.' Taking two to four years to study, they must memorize 25,000 streets and 20,000 landmarks.
- ✓ The London Underground (known as the Tube) is the oldest and longest metro in the world, with over 270 stations and 400 km of tracks.

- TYPICAL TOUR:** 8-day total trip with 6-nights lodging + 1 overnight air. Groups have 3 days of matches against local schools (minimum of 3 matches per team during the trip), a sports leadership training session, 2 stadium tours and incredible sightseeing.
- INTL POINT OF ENTRY:** Groups will fly in/out of London Heathrow (LHR).
- DESTINATIONS:** Your trip will be based in London, England. Destination add-ons are available to Scotland, Ireland, Spain and Italy for sports tours. Please let us know if you wish to extend your tour to include multiple destinations.
- GENDER / TEAMS:** Open to boys and girls, ages 12 through 19. Schools are welcome to bring a mix of teams. An example would be one boys soccer team, two girls soccer teams, and one boys basketball team. Please let us know your intention so we can verify match competition.
- LOCAL MATCHES:** Matches against specific schools may vary, however as a general platform, we will play local matches against [Dr. Challoner's School](#), [Aylesbury School](#) and [Royal Latin School](#). Visiting schools may bring multiple teams and will be matched accordingly to age/ability. Visiting coaches/trainers may be asked to assist with various game duties as needed.
- PRACTICE / TRAINING:** Visiting teams will be given appropriate time and resources for warm-up and practice prior to game play.
- EQUIPMENT:** All game equipment will be provided. Please bring appropriate uniforming and any personal needs necessary.
- LEADERSHIP TRAINING:** Our final day will be spent with a specialized sports and leadership training course at [Berkhamsted School](#) with our partners at [Summit Achievements](#).
- LODGING:** Groups will have accommodation for 6-nights on standard tours. Lodging options include hotels and upscale hostels. Please let us know if you have any lodging preferences and/or specific rooming allocations needed. Lodging is typically quad occupancy for students in rooms with 2 queen beds; double occupancy for staff in rooms with 2 queen beds. All trip leaders should be prepared to present a credit card for incidental fees at check-in. This is generally held and then released after your departure.
- MEALS:** Hotel breakfasts are included daily however on departure, please understand that if you are required to depart the hotel prior to breakfast service hours, this will not be included. Dinners will be in dine-around fashion with one dinner/mixer at a local school. Lunches are purchased on own, paid for independently, at a variety of local stops. Lunch budget should be £15 GBP pp, per day of service.
- TRANSPORTATION:** Motorcoach transport is provided for the total length of tour but only calculated for the specific activities noted. If a different schedule is needed, please let us know and we can re-cost the transport elements. Typical motorcoaches can seat up to 60 passengers, double-deckers and mini-buses are also available in some cases.

- EMERGENCY OPS:** For medical care, guests are taken via ambulance to a local medical facility. Air evacuation and taxi services are also available based on severity. Groups should be prepared to pay for medical services on-site.
- INSURANCE:** All groups are required to carry group travel insurance / travel protection. If you are a USA-based group, this is available for purchase during registration if desired.
- AMBASSADOR:** We provide a local Ambassador with every group booking. We generally use a transport meet/greet person for arrivals and then our Ambassador will meet your group at your hotel.
- GRATUITIES:** As service positions earn their personal income from gratuities, please advise your groups on appropriate tipping of waitstaff for any meal services that are not 'included' in your itinerary such as lunches. This does not apply to self-serve/buffet options, only to options where you are physically served by waitstaff or a bartender. The typical tip is 10-15% of the total bill. Additionally, your Ambassador generally serves in a tipped position. For guidance and/or suggestions on gratuities, please contact us.
